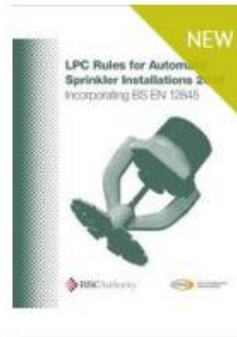
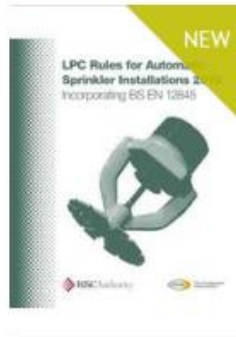




## Technical Workshop on LPC Sprinkler rules with BSEN12845
