- 1. 4 nos. FSSAG meetings from 2011 to 2012.
- 2. Major Discussions and conclusions arisen: -
 - 2. 1 FS CoP 2012 Edition issued, effective from April 2012 (including new checklist for AFA system to BS 5839:2002)
 - 2.2 Sprinkler under open suspended ceilings, racks, platform, floors, etc. fitted with water shield (dia. 75mm to 150mm) in compliance with Clause 14.7 of BSEN12845
 - 2.3 Capacity of Emergency Generator
 - Should allow for both fixed fire pump & intermediate booster pump.
 - Same principle for sprinkler system, drencher system, etc



- 2.4 Audio / Visual Advisory (AVA) System
 - Member should note the requirement stipulated in FS CoP.
 - Some major clarifications in 32nd FSSAG meeting.
- 2.5 Review on Fire Safety Standards for Emergency Lighting Systems (PPA 104 & PPA 104(A) in FSD Circular Letter No. 1/2006) in progress.
- 2.6 Use of Concealed / Recessed Sprinkler
 - FSD Circular Letter No. 4/96 stipulated fast response sprinklers required in basement.
 - Only concealed sprinkler with fast response element available in market.
 - Concealed / recessed sprinkler <u>NOT</u> suitable for use in basement.

In last year, FSICA continued to have join effort with FEMC and all CAs to undergo various important Legal and Contract issues in E&M Industry via various Task Forces and External Committees with Government Bureaus / Departments and CIC. Major issues are extracted and reported as follows:

1. CIC – Task Force on Security of Payment

- Recent development indicated that DevB has direction for legislation on security of payment although CIC has not put forwards the final report of survey for payment problem.
- A taskforce will be form with industry stakeholders for developing an
 operating mechanism to take forward the legislation, and the operating
 mechanism will be implemented as contractual requirements in some public
 works. Preparatory works for legislation process based on experience
 gained from these public works will commence in parallel as mentioned.



2. CIC – Task Force on Security of Payment (cont'd)

• FEMC has sent strong letter to DevB expressing strong view in putting forward security of payment for legislation in order to allow the implementation of it extended to private sector contracts which were even more serious.

3. **DevB** – **Plumbing Listing**

- Consultation paper on establishing the listing of plumbing installation was issued by DevB in June 2012.
- FSICA had returned a comment to DevB that the scope of category
 proposed to be revised to avoid the installation scope of plumbing
 incorrectly limited the pumps, up-feed and own-feed of the FS system to
 be taken up by the plumbing installation.




4. CIC – Task Force on NEC3 Collaborative Contracts

- An introductory seminar on NEC3 organized by DevB was held on 31 May 2012.
- Both DSD & ASD will have more trial Contracts adopting NEC3.
- Members to observe the various contract option of NEC3 to be adopted by client and main contractor.
- Special attention is also drawn concerning the procedure of selecting (i.e. Naming) specialist E&M subcontractors by main contractor in execution of NEC3 contract.
- In the meeting dated 7 June 2012 with DevB and DSD for clarifying the matter, FEMC was given an assurance that all specialist contractors on the approval list will be invited to tender for the concerned E&M work after the main contractor had been award and Dutch auction will be strictly prohibited.



4. Wage Fluctuation for E&M Term Maintenance Contracts

- EMSD informed that a proposal for contract provision, for wage fluctuation in A/C, FS and Lifts & Escalators term maintenance contracts had been formulated.
- The sounding out exercise with industry would be held in June to July 2012 and expected to collect industry feedback in August 2012.
- At present, there is option for individual trade association (AC, FS, Lift) to adopt such wage fluctuation or not before completion of consultation to industry
- It was anticipated that the contracts incorporated with wage fluctuation provision could be rolled out by end of 2012.



5. CCTS for E&M Trades for ASD project over HK\$50M

HKFEMC agreed the "Mandatory" CCTS for E&M Trades with the following qualification:

- Trial Run for 12 months then reviews to continue or not.
- The number of trainee in one contract is reduced to 2 nos. or 2% of the estimated total manpower demand in the contract.
- After the completion of training, the extended 12 months employment for the graduated trainee should be in daily wage HK\$420/day or HK\$10,000/month for first 6 months, HK\$620/day or HK\$15,000/month afterwards.
- The implementation of this CCTS for E&M trades would not interrupt with the existing E&M apprentice scheme.

Measures to Facilitate Payment over Pay for Site Safety & Environmental

•Template for required reports and Payment Submission Guideline are established.

Submission of As-fitted Drawings and O&M Manual

•1% to 1.7% of Contract Sum will be withheld until satisfactory submission.

Money Retained for Testing and Commissioning

•General guideline for typical domestic blocks is agreed with HKHA:

(a) Before T&C 7% of completed itemized values will be withheld

(b) After FSD Inspection 5% of itemized values will be released

(c) Final Tests with BSI 2% of itemized values will be further released

Remark: Above is retained only for incomplete T&C and Witnessed Tests, and apart from Major Defects & Retention Money for the contract.



Review of General Specification for FSWP

•FSICA had made the comments on the draft specifications.

Provision of Site Office for NSC

•Site office with telephone / broadband will be provided free-of-charge for NSC for future projects.

Product Certification by Independent Third Party and Surveillance Test

•Some FS products will be selected for trial run.

Sub-contractor Registration under VSRS

•All tiers of sub-contractors of TMC must be registered.


- The FSICA SSSVMS is designed to closely monitor the status of the sprinkler subsidiary valves to ensure that they are operating properly. The web-based Data Management system with its special features greatly helps to manage the sprinkler subsidiary valves to ensure their reliability and effectiveness
- ♦ With the support of the FSD and the Housing Authority, our committee has been able to successfully promote the use of our FSICA SSSVMS to FSI owners, property management companies and registered FSI contractors







- ◆ The complete FSICA SSSVMS has been in operation for just one year. The increasing number of users over the past six months proves that the function and effectiveness of the system has been well recognized and in particular the public awareness of fire safety has been upgraded. Our long term objective is to make this system used in all the sprinkler systems in Hong Kong
- ◆ In line with our original plan for the FSICA SSSVMS, we are now implementing the second stage by extending the usage of this system to the major components of other sprinkler systems which will be introduced in due course
- ◆ Furthermore, our committee is also responsible for upgrading the fire safety awareness of the public and will endeavour to achieve this important goal



 - 1. Structure of Third Party Proof Organizations

- Case Study on counterfeit products victims and define existing grey areas in current regulations and statutory issues




- Follow-ups with Government officials










Survey on counterfeit products in May-12


