**Coronavirus Disease Preventive Measures**

Due to Pandemic, all participants attending the CPD course must pass the temperature check before admission, follow the seating arrangement and wear their own face masks throughout the course. No eating or drinking is allowed inside the venue.

The number of delegates allowed in the venue is controlled by the Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation gazetted by the HKSAR from time to time. Depending on the development of the epidemic of COVID-19, the government may tighten the preventive measures and reduce the allowable number of delegates. Under such circumstances, we reserve the right to cancel any enrolment.
