## **Programme Highlights:**

# Part I: Clarification for FS Inspection Acceptance Criteria and FS Requirement

The workshop objectives are to clarify FS Inspection Acceptance Criteria and FS Requirement in recent FSD Inspections. During past FSSAG meetings, FSICA and other members have clarified with FSD on interpretation of Rules and Codes for acceptance criteria and requirement for FSD inspections. The Technical Committee of FSICA would like to share with you the discussions and conclusions made on these interpretations during past meetings, and explain more how to address the issues and reach the conclusions. The topics have included fail safe for VAC control, fail safe for pressurization of staircase system, fail safe for smoke extraction system, zoning of alarm sounders and provision of sprinkler inlets etc.

#### Part II: Smoke Control in Basement

In Hong Kong, fire safety for buildings is designed to several codes of practices in order to meet the Building Ordinance, Building (Planning) Regulations and Building (Construction) Regulations. These codes are prescriptive in nature and written to address typical buildings fire safety design. Requirements for basements are also given in the codes to address structures directly below a building. One of the requirements is to provide smoke extraction for basement over 3 storeys and each fire compartment in basement should be served by separate smoke extraction systems (i.e. fan, ductwork system and independent shaft). Such requirements sometimes are difficult or infeasible to be fulfilled particularly in the sites with small footprint. In this technical talk, Anny will share some examples of smoke control provision in basement projects and explain how fire engineering approach can address the design issues to optimize the smoke extraction system design for basements.
